1. APOLOGIES

Apologies were received from Mr B Black, Mr T Canavan, Mr D Flinn, Mr I Hill, Ms A Moreno, Mr J O'Neill, Mr John Moore, Dr K Muhr, Mr C Mallon, Dr F McCormick and Mr P Walsh.

2. DESCHEDULING

In accordance with the requirement for EHS to consult with Council under Article 3(6) of the Historic Monuments and Archaeological Objects (NI) Order 1995, Ms Foley introduced a paper on the proposed descheduling of ARM 11:10, Kennedies - circular enclosure, Co. Armagh. She outlined some of the history and condition of the site which had originally been scheduled in an attempt to protect it from quarrying activity.

Members considered the proposal and endorsed the descheduling of the Kennedies, but expressed concern that by doing so the other existing scheduled site close by could be placed under threat from further quarrying works. The Chairman asked EHS to report on the implications for the other site arising from the descheduling.
